

## **NRHA Internship Application**

#### Overview

The National Reining Horse Association (NRHA) offers many internships each year. The first internship is held during the NRHA Derby Show in June and the second is held during the NRHA Futurity & Adequan® North American Affiliate Championship Show beginning in late November. Applications are now being accepted for these opportunities.

Interns who are chosen to work during the NRHA Derby Show may be offered a summer internship based at the NRHA headquarters after the event. Determining factors will include budget, work ethic, reliability, and performance during the previously scheduled internship.

### **Duration**

NRHA Futurity (2 weeks) NRHA Derby (1.5 weeks)

\*\*Please note – you cannot serve as an intern and compete at NRHA Owned Events.

### Internship Requirements (i.e.: courses taken, previous experience)

The internship is based at the NRHA headquarters in Oklahoma City, Okla. and includes participation at the either the NRHA Derby Show or NRHA Futurity & Adequan North American Affiliate Championship Show. To be selected the candidate:

- must be willing to assist with all functions of the departments listed including early mornings and lengthy days during major events
- must be willing to work closely with youth members, leaders, and NRHA Staff
- must demonstrate an interest in the livestock or horse industry and have the ability to work collaboratively
- must be creative, energetic, patient and reliable

### Compensation

Stipend based on length of internship (daily rate during NRHA owned event of \$50/day, plus lodging and reimbursement for travel to and from show). Will assist with college credit.
